Call to ConfessionFrom Bucer's Strassburg Liturgy, 1539Pastor: Make confession to God the Lord, and let everyone acknowledge with me his sin and iniquity.

Confession of Sin (congregation kneels, as able) All: Almighty, eternal God and Father, we confess and acknowledge unto You that we were conceived in unrighteousness and are full of sin and transgression in all our life. We do not fully believe Your Word nor follow Your holy commandments. Remember Your goodness, we beseech You, and for Your Name's sake be gracious unto us, and forgive us our iniquity which, alas, is great. [Silent prayer of confession] Amen.

### † Assurance of Pardon

Pastor: "This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners." Let each of you truly acknowledge that he is a sinner, humbling himself before God, and believe that the heavenly Father wills to be gracious unto him in Jesus Christ. To all those that repent in this way, and look to Jesus Christ for their salvation, I declare that the absolution of sins is effected, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
